House Bill 302 as reported by the Committee on Judiciary would increase the obligations of the Alabama Professional Bail Bonding Board by an estimated \$703 per meeting of the board by adding two additional members to the board.

In addition, this bill codifies existing practice for collection of late fees for certain licenses and establishes a renewal fee for an inactive license of \$100 and a late fee of \$100 for failure to renew an inactive license.

Finally this bill could increase the administrative obligations of certain circuit clerks to submit the list of authorized professional surety companies and bail bond companies to the presiding judge of the circuit and the Board pursuant to the provisions of this bill.
