House Bill 329 as reported by the Committee on Education Policy would codify an existing rule of the State Department of Education to require public school students, beginning with students who will graduate during the 2031-2032 school year, to earn at least one credit in a department approved computer science course, or a department approved course with embedded computer science skills and experiences. This bill could increase the administrative obligations of the department to ensure that computer science courses meet certain instructional criteria.
