REVISED

House Bill 309 as introduced would increase the obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency to establish and administer a domestic violence offender registry by an agency-estimated \$1.0 million in development costs and \$500,000 for annual maintenance and personnel costs.

In addition this bill would establish a \$150 domestic violence offender registration fee distributed as follows: (1) \$50 to the clerk of court, which could offset, in whole or in part, any increase in administrative obligations to comply with the provisions of this bill; and (2) \$100 to the Domestic Violence Trust Fund.
