House Bill 67 as passed the House of Representatives would increase or decrease receipts to the Voter Registration Fund by an undetermined amount dependent on the difference in collections from: 1) the current one-cent per electronic voter record fee, set by the Secretary of State under current law; and 2) the amount set by the secretary up to \$1000 per voter list, as provided by this law.

According to the Secretary of State's Office, the office received 874 voter list requests in 2025, which generated approximately \$426,000 in receipts.
