Senate Bill 6 as introduced would revise the penalty on entities that fail to get a waiver to rename, relocate, remove, alter or otherwise disturb public property until the property has been restored to its original condition from \$25,000 per violation to \$5,000 per day per violation until full restorative action has been taken to comply with the provision of the Alabama Memorial Preservation Act.

This bill would increase the obligations of the governmental entities that maintain architecturally significant buildings or memorial buildings, by an undetermined amount, to erect markers naming any resulting building, park or green space after the individual or event the building was originally named.

This bill would also authorize the Attorney General to stay the fines upon submission of supporting documentation that restoration has begun.
