House Bill 52 as introduced could increase receipts to the State General Fund, county general funds, and other funds to which court costs are deposited by an undetermined amount depending on the number of civil actions filed under the extended statute of limitation for victims of sex offenses as provided by this bill.

In addition, this bill could increase the obligations of the Office of Attorney General, by an undetermined amount, to develop and implement a public awareness campaign to inform survivors of sexual abuse of their rights under this bill.

The enactment of this bill is contingent on the ratification of a Constitutional Amendment provided in House Bill 53 of the 2026 Regular Session.
