Senate Bill 113 (Act 2026-144) as enacted converts the current Alabama Behavior Analyst Licensing Board, under the Alabama Department of Mental Health (ADMH), to the Alabama Behavior Analyst Advisory Council and transfers all property of the Council to ADMH. This will increase the administrative obligations of ADMH by an undetermined amount dependent upon the costs to regulate behavioral analysts and other licensees of the former board. However, these obligations will be offset by license fees collected by ADMH from licensees.

In addition, this act renames the Alabama Behavior Analyst Licensing Board Fund to the Alabama Behavior Analyst Advisory Council Fund which shall be used by ADMH pursuant to the provisions of this act. For FY 2025, total estimated funds available to the Board were \$69,235.

Further, the provisions of this act could increase the administrative obligations of the Department of Rehabilitation Services (DRS), if ADMH collaborates and partners with DRS to implement the provisions of this act.
