House Bill 1 as introduced could increase receipts to the various funds that receive a distribution from the existing \$200 court fee by requiring the installation of an approved ignition interlock device upon the first conviction of driving under the influence. The required \$200 fee for each ignition interlock device is distributed as follows:

- 17% to the Alabama Interlock Indigent Fund (\$34)
- 30% to either the State Judicial Administration Fund for cases in state circuit or district court (\$60)
- 30% to the municipal judicial administration fund for cases in municipal court (\$60) or
- 30% to the Highway Traffic Safety Fund (\$60)
- 23% to the District Attorney's Solicitor Fund (\$46)
