House Bill 300 as introduced would require certain health benefit plans that provide coverage for a supplemental or diagnostic breast examination to not impose any cost-sharing requirements on enrollees, which could increase the costs of the State Employees' Health Insurance Plan (SEHIP) and the Public Employees' Health Insurance Plan (PEEHIP) by an undetermined amount dependent on: (1) if molecular breast imaging is required to be covered, (2) how many more breast examinations will be required to be covered due to family history, and (3) if the bill is requiring coverage for out-of-network services.
