Senate Bill 75 as passed the Senate could increase or decrease the obligations of certain state agencies, local governments, and local boards of education by an undetermined amount dependent upon the difference in the cost of materials or equipment purchased through competitive bidding agre under current law compared to cooperative purchase agreements under this bill.

This bill could also increase or decrease the obligations of certain local governments and local boards of education by an undetermined amount by requiring that all goods and services purchased by these entities, through a purchasing cooperative comply with current state competitive bidding laws.
