House Bill 268 as reported by the Committee on County and Municipal Government would increase the obligations of the Alabama 911 Board, paid from the 911 Fund, by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to: (1) establish a system to measure readiness of public safety services; (2) conduct performance audits of certain local 911 districts; and (3) provide and supervise remediation plans for certain local 911 districts.

In addition, the bill could increase the administrative obligations of the Office of the Attorney General to comply with the provisions of this bill.
