House Bill 541 as passed the House of Representatives could increase the obligations of the Office of the Secretary of State by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to the office to revise the voter application form, store and retain voter history information, and to adopt rules to implement the provisions of this bill regarding the registration of electors to a political party affiliation.

This bill could also increase the obligations of the boards of registrars by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to store and retain voter history information and to process party affiliation changes.
