House Bill 520 as passed the House of Representatives could increase the obligations of the local boards of education by an undetermined amount dependent on the amount of relocation stipends or hiring incentives paid by boards that elect to offer such incentives to individuals that relocate from another state and are certified to teach career and technical education courses pursuant to this bill.

Additionally, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of the State Board of Education and the Alabama Department of Education to adopt rules to establish the expedited teacher certificates pursuant to this bill and to provide an annual report on the efficacy of the program.
