House Bill 487 as passed the House of Representatives would appropriate a total of \$43,138,650 from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund for fiscal year 2026 to the following entities in the following amounts:

- Board of Pardons and Paroles: \$1.5 million;
- Department of Mental Health: \$26,360,000;
- Auburn University: \$1.9 million;
- University of Alabama at Birmingham: \$2 million;
- USA Health University of South Alabama: \$1.1 million;
- Administrative Office of Courts for Specialty Courts: \$3 million;
- District Attorneys: \$2.1 million;
- Child Advocacy Centers: \$2,136,650
- Office of Prosecution Services: \$1,092,000;
- Department of Forensic Sciences: \$450,000;
- Department of Senior Services: \$500,000;
- Department of Corrections: \$1 million.

This bill would also provide that these funds would not revert at the end of fiscal year 2026 but would carry forward for the purposes appropriated.
