House Bill 487 (Act 2026-602) as enacted appropriates a total of \$43,138,650 from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund for fiscal year 2026 to the following entities in the following amounts:

- Board of Pardons and Paroles: \$1.5 million;
- Department of Mental Health: \$26,360,000;
- Auburn University: \$1.9 million;
- University of Alabama at Birmingham: \$2 million;
- USA Health University of South Alabama: \$1.1 million;
- Administrative Office of Courts for Specialty Courts: \$3 million;
- District Attorneys: \$2.1 million;
- Child Advocacy Centers: \$2,136,650
- Office of Prosecution Services: \$1,092,000;
- Department of Forensic Sciences: \$450,000;
- Department of Senior Services: \$500,000;
- Department of Corrections: \$1 million.

Further, this act transfers the \$5 million that was appropriated to the Department of Mental Health by Act 2025-255 to the Department of Public Health and appropriates these funds to establish a dedicated opioid treatment center using the Therapeutic Community Treatment Model through an RFP.

This act also provides that these funds would not revert at the end of fiscal year 2026 but would carry forward for the purposes appropriated.
