**House Bill 332** as introduced would increase the obligations of the Department of Human Resources (DHR), in consultation with the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) and the Alabama Board of Pharmacy, by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to develop an anaphylactic response policy to be utilized by licensed day care centers. Further, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Department of Public Health to: (1) select an entity to complete anaphylaxis training program to be used by employees of licensed day care centers; and (2) develop a form to be used by the selected entity as a certificate to show completion of the training.
