House Bill 332 as passed the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security would increase the obligations of the Department of Human Resources (DHR), in consultation with the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) and the Alabama Board of Pharmacy, by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to develop an anaphylactic response policy to be utilized by licensed day care centers. Further, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Department of Public Health to develop licensed day care centers a certificate to show completion of the training.
