Senate Bill 108 as introduced would increase the obligations of the Alabama National Guard Education Assistance Program (ANGEAP) by an undetermined amount to provide tuition assistance for: (1) accredited and non-accredited but approved certification or stand-alone training as part of a workforce development program; and (2) the per term costs of required on-campus living expenses and meal plans.

Additionally, this bill would cap payments for tuition, fees, ancillary costs, and per term cost of required on-campus living expenses and meal plans at an amount not to exceed the median cost of tuition per term of all public four-year institutions of higher education in the state. For the 2025-26 school year the median cost of tuition per term is \$12,454.
