4 SYNOPSIS:

5                   This bill would reopen the Teachers' Retirement  
6                   System to allow an active, vested, and contributing  
7                   member to purchase credit in the system for prior  
8                   service rendered to the St. Clair County Day Program,  
9                   Incorporated.

12                   A BILL

13                   TO BE ENTITLED

14                   AN ACT

16                   To reopen the Teachers' Retirement System to permit  
17                   purchase of credit in the system for prior service rendered to  
18                   the St. Clair County Day Program, Incorporated.

19                   BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20                   Section 1. (a) The governing body of the St. Clair  
21                   County Day Program, Incorporated, by resolution legally  
22                   adopted to conform to the rules prescribed by the Board of  
23                   Control of the Teachers' Retirement System, may elect to have  
24                   its executive officers and full-time employees, from whatever  
25                   source and in whatever manner paid, become eligible to  
26                   participate in the Teachers' Retirement System of Alabama,  
27                   subject to all rules, regulations, and conditions thereof.

28                   (b) After the governing body of the St. Clair County



29 Day Program, Incorporated, has made an election through a  
30 resolution as provided in subsection (a), its employees and  
31 executive officers may participate in and be entitled to all  
32 benefits of the Teachers' Retirement System of Alabama;  
33 provided, that where contributions are made from salaries paid  
34 by the St. Clair County Day Program, Incorporated, the St.  
35 Clair County Day Program, Incorporated, shall pay the employer  
36 cost, calculated as a percentage of the salaries of those  
37 employees, to be contributed as employer contributions in  
38 accordance with Section 16-25-21, Code of Alabama 1975. The  
39 amount shall be paid monthly and at the same time as the  
40 members' contributions are made to the Teachers' Retirement  
41 System.

42 (c) The governing body of the St. Clair County Day  
43 Program, Incorporated, may provide in its resolution to the  
44 Teachers' Retirement System's Board of Control that all  
45 service rendered by an eligible employee or executive officer  
46 to the program, before the effective date of the program's  
47 election to come under the Teachers' Retirement System, shall  
48 be creditable service to the employee or executive officer;  
49 provided, that any provision shall apply only to those  
50 employees and officers who were in the active service of the  
51 program on the effective date of the program's election to be  
52 covered under the Teachers' Retirement System; and provided  
53 further, that the resolution also states that the St. Clair  
54 County Day Program, Incorporated, shall assume and pay, as  
55 required, all costs necessary to fund the crediting of the  
56 previous service, the costs to be determined by the actuary

57 employed by the Teachers' Retirement System Board of Control.  
58 All benefits that accrue and are payable to any beneficiary  
59 hereunder shall be limited to, and shall not exceed, the  
60 amount paid in by the beneficiary and the employer plus his or  
61 her portion of the interest earned and the enhancement of his  
62 or her monies by investing them, less cost of administration,  
63 at no cost to the State of Alabama.

64 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
65 2026.
