SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, circuit clerks are not authorized to participate in both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System.

This bill would authorize circuit clerks who independently qualify for a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System based on separate years of service to participate in both programs.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to retirement benefits; to add Section 12-18-166 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize qualifying circuit clerks to participate in both a supernumerary circuit clerk program and the Employees' Retirement System.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 12-18-166 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§12-18-166

(a) No individual may participate in both a supernumerary circuit clerk program and the Employees' Retirement System based on the same service.
