## HB191 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama  
3 of 2022, relating to Escambia County, to further provide for  
4 where the district court may hold court in certain cases.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
7 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 In Escambia County, the district court may hold court  
10 in the county courthouse for cases arising under the  
11 ordinances of any municipality in the county in which there is  
12 no municipal court.

13 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the  
14 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as  
15 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional  
16 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:  
17 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation  
18 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest  
19 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise  
20 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize  
21 language; and translate effective dates.

### END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

23 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
24 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285  
25 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws  
26 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign  
27 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on  
28 the election ballot and shall set forth the following

29 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed  
30 constitutional amendment:

31 "Relating to Escambia County, proposing an amendment to  
32 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to further provide for  
33 where the district court may hold court in certain cases.

34 Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_."

35 This description shall be followed by the following  
36 language:

37 "Yes( ) No( )."

38 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as  
39 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by  
40 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
