71 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

72         Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations  
73 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
74 \$1,200,000 from the Personnel Fund to the State Personnel  
75 Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

76         Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations  
77 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
78 \$34,000,000, estimated, in federal funds from the American  
79 Rescue Plan Act - Small Business Credit Initiative Fund to the  
80 Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
81 2026. These funds may be delegated through memoranda of  
82 agreement to the Alabama Innovation Corporation or other  
83 entity so designated by the Department of Finance.

84         Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations

85 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
86 \$588,612 from the Federal Stimulus Fund to Alabama Medicaid  
87 Agency for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

88 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations  
89 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
90 \$16,000,000 from the Alabama Energy Infrastructure Fund to the  
91 State Industrial Development Authority for the fiscal year  
92 ending September 30, 2026.

93 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations  
94 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
95 \$50,000,000 from the Strategic Energy Infrastructure  
96 Development Fund to the State Industrial Development Authority  
97 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

98 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations  
99 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
100 \$3,600,000 from the Administrative Office of Courts Federal  
101 and Local Funds Fund to the Unified Judicial System for the  
102 fiscal year ending September 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law  
103 to the contrary, the funds appropriated under this section may  
104 be spent on salaries and personnel costs and for other general  
105 operations of the Unified Judicial System.

106 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations  
107 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
108 \$2,300,000 from the Court Automation Fund to the Unified  
109 Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.  
110 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds  
111 appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and  
112 personnel costs and for other general operations of the

113 Unified Judicial System.

114                   Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations  
115 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
116 \$1,000,000 from the Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund  
117 to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending  
118 September 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,  
119 the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on  
120 salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations  
121 of the Unified Judicial System.

122                   Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations  
123 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
124 \$4,100,000 from the State Judicial Administration Fund to the  
125 Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September  
126 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds  
127 appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and  
128 personnel costs and for other general operations of the  
129 Unified Judicial System.

130                   Section 10. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
131 2026, up to \$22,137,949 shall be transferred from the  
132 Refundable Tax Credit Fund to the Legislative Council Fund.

133                   Section 11. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
134 2026, \$13,000,000 shall be transferred from the Real Property  
135 Management Fund to the Legislative Council Fund.

136                   Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations  
137 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated up  
138 to \$35,137,949 from the Legislative Council Fund to the  
139 Legislative Council for construction and related expenses for  
140 the new State House for fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

141                   Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations  
142                   heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
143                   \$1,000,000 from the Vaping and Licensing Enforcement Fund to  
144                   the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for fiscal year  
145                   ending September 30, 2026.

146                   Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations  
147                   heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated up  
148                   to \$1,000,000 from the Consumable Hemp Product Compliance Fund  
149                   to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for fiscal  
150                   year ending September 30, 2026.

151                   Section 15. Notwithstanding any other provisions of  
152                   this act or any other act, any amounts from appropriations for  
153                   the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, to the various  
154                   state agencies in this act which were unexpended and reverted  
155                   on September 30, 2026, are hereby reappropriated to the  
156                   respective offices for the fiscal year beginning October 1,  
157                   2026.

158                   Section 16. This act shall become effective immediately  
159                   upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its  
160                   otherwise becoming law.
