SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, sheriffs are not authorized to participate in both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System.

This bill would authorize sheriffs who independently qualify for a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System based on separate years of service to participate in both programs.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to retirement benefits; to authorize qualifying sheriffs to participate in both a supernumerary sheriff program and the Employees' Retirement System.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) No individual may participate in both a supernumerary sheriff program and the Employees' Retirement System based on the same service.

(b) An individual who independently qualifies for a supernumerary sheriff program and the Employees' Retirement System based on separate years of service may participate in both programs.
