1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Randolph County; to provide for the salary
3 of the county revenue commissioner; and to amend Section
4 45-56-83, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide for the salary of
5 the judge of probate.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. (a) Effective commencing on the next term of
8 office of the county revenue commissioner, the Revenue
9 Commissioner of Randolph County shall receive an annual salary
10 of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) per year payable in
11 equal bi-weekly installments.

12 (b) The salary provided by this section shall be in
13 lieu of any salary or other compensation provided by law and
14 shall be paid from the same funding sources as the salary of
15 the revenue commissioner is paid on October 1, 2026.

16 (c) The revenue commissioner shall be eligible for any
17 cost-of-living increases granted to other county officers.

18 Section 2. Section 45-56-83, Code of Alabama 1975, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 "§45-56-83

21 (a) ~~(1) Pursuant to Amendment 459 to the Constitution of~~
22 ~~Alabama of 1901, the Judge of Probate of Randolph County shall~~
23 ~~be entitled to receive total compensation in accordance with~~
24 ~~Section 12-13-20. The salary shall be paid in lieu of all~~
25 ~~other fees, allowances, and percentages heretofore provided by~~
26 ~~law, and shall be paid in equal in the same manner~~
27 ~~installments out of the general fund of the county as county~~
28 ~~employees are paid. Effective commencing on October 1, 2027,~~

29 the Judge of Probate of Randolph County shall receive an
30 annual salary of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) per year
31 payable in equal bi-weekly installments.

32 (2) The salary provided by this subsection shall be in
33 lieu of any salary or other compensation provided by law and
34 shall be paid from the same funding sources as the salary of
35 the judge of probate is paid on October 1, 2026.

36 (3) The judge of probate shall be eligible for any
37 cost-of-living increases granted to other county officers.

38 (b) All fees, commissions, allowances, percentages, and
39 other charges ~~heretofore~~ collected for the use of the judge of
40 probate, ~~hereafter~~ shall be collected and paid into the
41 general fund of the county.

42 (c) Upon the recommendation of the judge of probate,
43 the governing body of Randolph County shall provide the
44 probate office with office personnel, clerks, deputies, and
45 quarters, books, stationery, furniture, equipment, and other
46 conveniences and supplies as are necessary for the proper and
47 efficient conduct of the office. The judge of probate shall
48 appoint a chief clerk who shall have the same power as the
49 judge of probate, except the power to preside in a contested
50 cause. Compensation of any personnel so provided shall be
51 fixed by the county governing body and shall be paid in equal
52 installments out of the general fund of the county, as other
53 county employees are paid.

54 Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
55 1, 2026.
