## HB374 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 Relating to Montgomery County; to amend Section  
4 45-51-84, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the  
5 compensation of the judge of probate.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 45-51-84, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "§45-51-84

10 (a) The per annum compensation shall be eighty-eight  
11 thousand dollars (\$88,000) for the judge of probate effective  
12 October 1, 1996.

13 (b) The compensation amount in subsection (a) shall be  
14 paid out of the general fund of the Montgomery County  
15 Commission in the same manner as other county employees are  
16 paid.

17 (c) Subsequent to October 1, 1996, the compensation  
18 amount in subsection (a) shall be increased by the same  
19 percentage as the across-the-board percentage increase  
20 received by full-time county employees at the same time as the  
21 increase is received by the county employees, except that the  
22 amount shall not be increased by more than three thousand  
23 dollars (\$3,000) in any fiscal year.

24 (d) Beginning October 1, 2026, the individual serving  
25 as judge of probate on June 1, 2025, in lieu of any other  
26 salary, shall receive an annual salary of one hundred  
27 fifty-three thousand seven hundred twenty-five dollars  
28 (\$153,725) per year."
