1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Tallapoosa County; to provide for the  
4 salary of the county revenue commissioner; and to provide for  
5 the salary of the judge of probate.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. (a) Until the next term of office, the  
8 Revenue Commissioner of Tallapoosa County shall continue to  
9 receive the same base annual salary that the revenue  
10 commissioner is receiving on May 31, 2026.

11 (b) Beginning on June 1, 2026, in addition to the base  
12 annual salary authorized in subsection (a), the revenue  
13 commissioner shall receive an expense allowance in such amount  
14 as necessary so that the total annual compensation received  
15 equals one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per annum,  
16 payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund of  
17 the county.

18 (c) (1) Effective beginning with the next term of  
19 office, the revenue commissioner shall receive a base annual  
20 salary of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per annum,  
21 payable in equal monthly installments, and subsections (a) and  
22 (b) are void.

23 (2) The salary provided by this subsection shall be in  
24 lieu of any salary or other compensation provided by law and  
25 shall be paid from the same funding sources as the salary of  
26 the revenue commissioner is paid on June 1, 2026.

27 Section 2. (a) Until the next term of office, the Judge  
28 of Probate of Tallapoosa County shall continue to receive the

29 same base annual salary that the judge of probate is receiving  
30 on May 31, 2026.

31 (b) Beginning on June 1, 2026, in addition to the base  
32 annual salary authorized in subsection (a), the judge of  
33 probate shall receive an expense allowance in such amount as  
34 necessary so that the total annual compensation received  
35 equals one hundred and six thousand dollars (\$106,000) per  
36 annum, payable in equal monthly installments from the general  
37 fund of the county.

38 (c) (1) Effective beginning with the next term of  
39 office, the judge of probate shall receive a base annual  
40 salary of one hundred and six thousand dollars (\$106,000) per  
41 annum, payable in equal monthly installments from the same  
42 funding sources as the salary of the judge of probate is paid  
43 on June 1, 2026, and subsections (a) and (b) are void.

44 (2) The salary provided by this subsection shall be in  
45 lieu of any salary provided by law and shall supersede the  
46 compensation provided to the judge of probate in Act 275, 1969  
47 Regular Session (Acts 1969, p. 607-608), as amended by Act  
48 437, 1978 Regular Session (Acts 1978, p. 449-450), and the  
49 specific provisions of that act are void.

50 Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
51 2026.
