25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
27	following terms have the following meanings:

28 (1) AGENCY. A county or municipal agency that requires

- 31 (2) QUALIFYING OFFICER. A law enforcement officer
- 32 employed by and in good standing with an agency at the time of

- 34 (b) An agency shall present a qualifying officer with
- 35 his or her agency-issued badge as part of his or her
- 36 retirement benefits.
- 37 (c) An agency may present a qualifying officer with his
- 38 or her agency-issued pistol as part of his or her retirement
- 39 benefits.
- 40 (d) If an agency chooses not to act pursuant to
- 41 subsection (c), the agency, at the time of the qualifying
- 42 officer's retirement, may offer to sell the qualifying
- officer's agency-issued pistol to the qualifying officer at a
- 44 reasonable fair market price determined by the agency.
- 45 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 46 1, 2026.
