5	This bill would prohibit any government entity
6	from using the term "West Bank" to refer to Judea and
7	Samaria in any official government document.
8	This bill would also provide a mechanism for the
9	head of a government entity to waive the prohibition.

13	TO BE ENTITLED
14	AN ACT
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16	Relating to state government; to prohibit any
17	government entity from using the term "West Bank" to refer to
18	Judea and Samaria; to provide a waiver from the prohibition;
19	and to provide Legislative findings.
20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. The Legislature finds and declares the
22	following:
23	(1) The regions known as Judea and Samaria are the
24	ancestral heartland of the Jewish people, comprising the
25	historical, spiritual, and geographical core of the Land of
26	Israel.
27	(2) The names "Judea" and "Samaria" are the
28	historically, biblically, and legally accurate terms for the

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- 29 region. "Samaria" derives from the city established by King
- 30 Omri, as recorded in 1 Kings 16:24. "Judea" refers to the
- 31 territory of the Tribe of Judah, which included Jerusalem,
- 32 Hebron, and surrounding regions.
- 33 (3) The use of the term "West Bank" is a deliberate
- 34 attempt to erase the Jewish identity of Judea and Samaria and
- 35 to obscure the deep historical, religious, and legal
- 36 connections of the Jewish people to the land.
- 37 Section 2. (a) For the purposes of this act, the
- 38 following terms have the following meanings:
- 39 (1) GOVERNMENT ENTITY. The state, including any
- 40 subdivision, agency, or instrumentality thereof.
- 41 (2) JUDEA AND SAMARIA. The land liberated by Israel
- from Jordan during the 1967 Six-Day War by its historical name
- of "Judea and Samaria," with the land south of Jerusalem being
- 44 considered "Judea" and the land north of Jerusalem being
- 45 considered "Samaria."
- 46 (3) OFFICIAL GOVERNMENT MATERIAL. Any guidance, rule,
- 47 material, briefing, press release, communication, or work
- 48 product document prepared by a government entity.
- 49 (b) No government entity may:
- 50 (1) Use the term "West Bank" to refer to Judea and
- 51 Samaria in any official government material; or
- 52 (2) Use state funds to create an official government
- 53 material that refers to Judea and Samaria as "West Bank."
- 54 (c) The executive head of a government entity may waive
- 55 the prohibition provided in subsection (b) if he or she does
- 56 both of the following:



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- 57 (1) Determines that it is in the interests of the state 58 to waive the prohibition.
- 59 (2) No later than 30 days after the date on which he or 60 she determines it is in the interests of the state to waive
- 61 the prohibition, submits a written explanation of the waiver
- 62 to:
- a. The Legislature, if the Legislature is in session;
- 64 or
- b. The Legislative Council, if the Legislature is not
- 66 in session.
- 67 Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
- 68 1, 2026.
