29 at the time of ratification of this amendment shall be

30 eligible to purchase service credit in the Employees'

31 Retirement System of Alabama for the time the official has

32 served in that office. No person may participate in both a

33 supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System of

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest

grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 41

internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 42

43 language; and translate effective dates.

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT 44

> Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
