SYNOPSIS:

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to St. Clair County, to allow mayors of municipalities located in the county to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under certain conditions.

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to St. Clair County; to allow mayors of municipalities in the county to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under certain conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

In St. Clair County, the mayor of a municipality that participates in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama may participate in the retirement system upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law for any other employee in the same retirement system. A mayor holding office

at the time of ratification of this amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama for the time the official has served in that office. No person may participate in both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama based on the same service.

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize language; and translate effective dates.

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to St. Clair County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to allow mayors to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under certain conditions.

61 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
62 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by
