1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama  
4 of 2022, relating to Tuscaloosa County, to authorize the  
5 mayors of municipalities in the county to participate in the  
6 Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under the same terms  
7 and conditions as other employees in the same retirement  
8 system.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
11 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

12 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

13 In Tuscaloosa County, full-time mayors of  
14 municipalities in the county may participate in the Employees'  
15 Retirement System of Alabama under the same terms and  
16 conditions as other employees in the same retirement system.  
17 Any mayor holding office at the time of the ratification of  
18 this amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in  
19 the Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has  
20 served in the current office. No individual may participate in  
21 both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement  
22 System based on the same service.

23 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the  
24 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as  
25 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional  
26 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:  
27 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation  
28 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest

29 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise  
30 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize  
31 language; and translate effective dates.

32 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

33 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
34 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285  
35 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws  
36 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign  
37 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on  
38 the election ballot and shall set forth the following  
39 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed  
40 constitutional amendment:

41 "Relating to Tuscaloosa County, proposing an amendment  
42 to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the  
43 full-time mayors of municipalities in the county to  
44 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama  
45 under the same terms and conditions as other employees in the  
46 same retirement system.

47 Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_."

48 This description shall be followed by the following  
49 language:

50 "Yes( ) No( )."

51 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as  
52 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by  
53 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
