7 WHEREAS, it is with an overwhelming sense of loss, we
8 mourn the untimely death, yet celebrate the life, of Ella
9 Cobbs Cook of Birmingham, Alabama, whose passing took place
10 on December 13, 2025, at Brown University in Providence,
11 Rhode Island; and

13 Bishop Cook and Richard Poellnitz Cook in Birmingham; she
14 was the sister of Richard Hooker Poellnitz Cook and Mary
15 Hamner Cook; and

17 concentrating in French and Mathematics-Economics; before
18 college, she graduated from Mountain Brook High School; Ella
19 was an active, lifelong member of Cathedral Church of the
20 Advent in Birmingham; and

21 WHEREAS, Ella was known for a wide array of
22 interests, including spending time with her precious
23 friends, babysitting many children who were special to her,
24 teaching young people in Bible studies, Sunday school, and
25 academic subjects; she had a love for piano, dance, spending
26 time outdoors in Hale County, and traveling anywhere,

28 WHEREAS, the quality of Ella's personality and soul

that most touched others was her Christian faith; she genuinely believed in Christ's death and resurrection, and wanted to share the good new of grace she had received; she lived out her faith in her care and concern for others; she loved everyone with her whole heart; and

WHEREAS, her quiet demeanor was eclipsed by a heart as large as the sun; she led by putting others before herself; her siblings described her as protective, responsible, and selfless; Ella was adored by her circle of friends from Birmingham to Providence, and her sudden death has inspired immeasurable gratitude from all who knew her; and

WHEREAS, left to cherish her memory are her parents; brother and sister; grandparents, Deane Poellnitz Cook, Arthur Philip Cook, Jr., Katherine Stephens Bishop, and William Moss Bishop; uncles and aunts, Arthur Philip Cook III, Morgan Cook, Leigh Bishop, David Taub, Sissy Bishop Austin, and David Austin; beloved family member, Sandra McCollum; and seven special first cousins; now therefore,
