WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, we highly honor Captain Ted Johnson for his outstanding service, leadership, and dedication to the residents of Mobile and the Mobile Police Department; and

WHEREAS, a native of Mobile, Captain Johnson graduated from W.P. Davidson High School before beginning a distinguished career in public safety; he joined the Mobile Police Department in 2006 and was first assigned to the First Precinct as a patrol officer, where he quickly demonstrated a commitment to professionalism and community engagement; and

WHEREAS, over the years, he has served in several important roles including motor officer in the Traffic Safety Unit and supervisor in the Second Precinct, where he led felony suspect apprehension efforts, general investigations, and patrol operations; and

WHEREAS, Captain Johnson rose through the ranks and was promoted to lieutenant; in that role, he served as the unit commander for the Cyber Intelligence Unit, the Real-Time Information Center, and the Crime Scene Unit; these positions required advanced leadership, investigative

36 WHEREAS, Captain Johnson is also deeply committed to  
37 education and mentorship; he holds two Bachelor of Arts  
38 degrees in Criminal Justice and Russian Language, as well as  
39 a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the  
40 University of South Alabama, where he currently serves as a  
41 part-time faculty member, helping educate and inspire the  
42 next generation of leaders; and

43 WHEREAS, beyond his official duties, Captain Johnson  
44 has taken a proactive and compassionate approach to  
45 addressing homelessness in the Tillman's Corner area in  
46 Mobile County; he personally meets with individuals  
47 experiencing homelessness to explain local laws and connect  
48 them with resources such as identification services, housing  
49 assistance, employment opportunities, veteran support, and  
50 health care; and

51 WHEREAS, he has also coordinated partnerships with  
52 community organizations such as One Meal Mobile, which now  
53 uses the precinct as a staging area for weekly meals; as  
54 well as First Step Initiative, which assists individuals in  
55 obtaining identification, housing, and employment; and
