HJR___ EXTENDING THE JOINT INTERIM STUDY COMMISSION ON
EXPANDING ACCESS TO HIGH-QUALITY OUT-OF-SCHOOL EDUCATION
PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution 100, enacted as Act
2025-131 in the 2025 Regular Session, created the Joint
Interim Study Commission on Expanding Access to High-Quality
Out-of-School Education Programs to provide recommendations
for enhancing after school and summer educational
programming; and

WHEREAS, Act 2025-131 provided that the study
commission would submit findings, conclusions, and
recommendations to the Legislature no later than the
fifteenth day of the 2026 Regular Session, at which time the
study commission would be dissolved; and

WHEREAS, the study commission needs additional time
in order to continue to develop recommendations relating to
enhancing after school and summer educational programming;
now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Interim Study
Commission on Expanding Access to High-Quality Out-of-School
Education Programs, created pursuant to Act 2025-131, 2025
Regular Session, is extended.



HJR206 INTRODUCED

28 (a) The study commission shall prepare a report of
29 its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the
30 Legislature not later than November 1, 2026. Upon filing its
31 report with the Legislature, the study commission shall
32 stand dissolved and discharged of any future duties and
33 liabilities.

34 (b) Pursuant to Section 36-14-17.1, Code of Alabama
35 1975, the study commission shall provide to the Secretary of
36 State a notice of all meetings, the name of each member
37 serving on the study commission, and a copy of the final
38 report and any other documents produced by the study
39 commission throughout its duration.
