32 home in Four Points, Alabama, where they enjoy fellowship at  
33 a small, rural church; he is most at home working on his  
34 farm and managing timber in Deer Park, following in the  
35 footsteps of his maternal grandfather who taught him to  
36 appreciate and work the land; and

37           WHEREAS, throughout his service to the Alabama  
38 Legislature, Representative Easterbrook has served on  
39 various committees; he served as Vice Chair of the Insurance  
40 Committee and as a member of the Agriculture and Forestry  
41 Committee; Baldwin County Legislation Committee;  
42 Transportation, Utilities and Infrastructure Committee; Ways  
43 and Means General Fund Committee; and many others; and
