7 WHEREAS, we note with utmost admiration and
8 appreciation the distinguished service and tenure of
9 Representative Barbara Boyd to the Alabama House of
10 Representatives; and

11 WHEREAS, Representative Barbara Boyd has faithfully
12 served the residents of Alabama House District 32,
13 consisting of Calhoun and Talladega counties, since her
14 election in 1994, becoming one of the longest-serving
15 members of the Alabama House of Representatives; and

32 for mentoring newer legislators and contributing to

36 Boyd has remained deeply committed to community service
37 through her involvement with organizations such as the
38 NAACP, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Alpha
39 Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, and Murray Temple
40 Christian Methodist Episcopal Church in Anniston; and

42 Representative Barbara Boyd has earned the respect and
43 admiration of colleagues and constituents alike for her
44 dedication, leadership, and commitment to improving the
45 lives of the people of Alabama; now therefore,
