HJR___ DESIGNATING THE NEW LEGISLATIVE BUILDING AS THE ALABAMA STATE HOUSE.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of Alabama, pursuant to Section 48.02 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is authorized to designate by resolution a suitable place for the meeting of the Legislature, which place shall be known as the Alabama State House; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature will be relocating its principal operations to the newly constructed legislative building located within the Capitol Complex of Montgomery, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate for purposes of public identification, clarity in official records, and continuity of legislative operations that the new legislative building be formally designated as the Alabama State House; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That certain State of Alabama property located in the Capitol Complex of Montgomery, Alabama, bounded by state property formerly fronting Pelham Street on the North, Jackson Street on the East, Ripley Street on the West, and Washington Avenue on the South is hereby designated as the place of meeting for the Senate and House of Representatives of the Alabama Legislature for
