5 WHEREAS, with great pride and special reverence, we  
6 commend Dr. Leon Frazier for his many accomplishments; and

7 WHEREAS, he loved people genuinely and served others  
8 selflessly and his departure leaves a void in the lives of  
9 his loving family, many friends, and the community where he  
10 was highly regarded; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier was born on May 16, 1932; from a  
12 young age he pursued education, and it became a cornerstone  
13 of his life; he earned a Bachelor of Science in Education  
14 from South Carolina State College, a Master of Science in  
15 Guidance and Counseling from Alabama A&M University, and a  
16 Doctor of Education in Educational Psychology from Oklahoma  
17 State University; he completed further graduate study in  
18 Public Administration at the University of Oklahoma; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier's professional career includes  
20 noted experience as a public school teacher in South  
21 Carolina; civilian technical training instructor at the  
22 United States Air Force Electronics Training Center in  
23 Biloxi, Mississippi; and Technical Instructor Supervisor and  
24 Education Specialist, respectively, at the United States  
25 Army Missile School at Redstone Arsenal; and

26 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier served in many capacities in  
27 higher education as a professor, vice president, and in the  
28 Office of Student Affairs at Oklahoma State University and

29 Alabama A&M University; he also served as a Licensed  
30 Psychologist for the State of Alabama and State Commissioner  
31 of the Alabama Department of Pensions and Security; and

32 WHEREAS, he held positions of leadership with a  
33 number of public service organizations, including board  
34 president of the American Institute of Psychotherapy  
35 Graduate School of Psychology; president of the National  
36 Association of College Deans, Registrars, and Admissions  
37 Officers; and member of the Governor's Advisory Council on  
38 Humanitarian Services; in addition, he was a member of the  
39 job development subcommittee of the Alabama Development  
40 Commission and many other organizations and committees  
41 serving the community in meaningful ways; and

42 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier's faith-based leadership  
43 activities included serving as the Jurisdictional Executive  
44 Secretary and Finance Officer of Church of God in Christ,  
45 Alabama Second Jurisdiction; and Jurisdictional President of  
46 the youth department for 23 years; Dr. Frazier was Project  
47 Director for the founding and accreditation of the Apostolic  
48 School of Ministry of North Alabama; he provided counsel to  
49 many faith-based projects of churches in the Southeastern  
50 United States; and

51 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier was regarded highly in the  
52 communities where he resided and served; most notably are  
53 the schools that are named in his honor, including the  
54 Harris Home for Children and Frazier Preparatory School in  
55 Uganda, which has three campuses; and

56 WHEREAS, Dr. Frazier is preceded in death by his

58 children, all of whom earned college degrees; now therefore,
