HR _____ MOURNING THE DEATH OF CALVIN MILLER II.

WHEREAS, it is with deep sorrow and regret that we note the lamentable death of Calvin Miller II of Huntsville, Alabama, on March 8, 2026, at the age of 76 years; and

WHEREAS, a native of Detroit, Michigan, Calvin Miller II proudly served his country in the United States Army, retiring with the rank of Sergeant First Class in April 1988 after more than 20 years of honorable and faithful service; and

WHEREAS, following his military service, Mr. Miller continued a life of leadership and service through his extensive involvement in Freemasonry, beginning in Huntsville where he became a member of Evening Star Lodge No. 6 and was later initiated into the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, Prince Hall Affiliation, Southern Jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, his dedication within the Masonic order led to his elevation to the Honorary Thirty-Third Degree, and he was later coroneted as a Sovereign Grand Inspector General and made an Active Member of the United Supreme Council in October 2003; he further served with distinction as Deputy for the Orient of Alabama and as an Active Member until October 2018; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Miller's leadership extended further

29 through his service as Chair for the Committee on Class
30 Administration for the United States Supreme Council, where
31 he played a vital role in the preparation and advancement of
32 more than 2,500 Honorary Grand Inspectors General throughout
33 the Southern Jurisdiction; and

34 WHEREAS, he held numerous other Masonic distinguished
35 positions, including Past Master; Past Illustrious
36 Potentate; Past Patron; and Grand Worthy Patron for the
37 Mizpah Grand Chapter, Order of Eastern Star, Jurisdiction of
38 Alabama, where he faithfully served since 2014; and

39 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was also a man of deep faith,
40 serving as an ordained Elder at Madkins Chapel Cumberland
41 Presbyterian Church in Huntsville; and

42 WHEREAS, he was a devoted husband to his wife,
43 Sherran; father of six adult children; and proud grandfather
44 of 12; his love for his family was evident in all that he
45 did; and

46 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was a valued member of the
47 community and loved by many, and we join with others to
48 celebrate his life and to mourn his death; although his
49 presence will be greatly missed, his memory will be
50 cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were
51 fortunate to know him; now therefore,
