48 (c) ALEA shall maintain a detailed record of all



49 expenditures made in furtherance of this act and shall
50 submit a report quarterly on those expenditures to the
51 Governor, the Chair of the Finance and Taxation General
52 Fund Committee, the Chair of the House Ways and Means
53 General Fund Committee, and the mayor of any municipality
54 subject to operational oversight.

55 (d) The Chief Justice of the Alabama Supreme Court,
56 upon request from the Attorney General, may appoint a
57 sitting or retired circuit judge to preside over all
58 proceedings under this section. If the Chief Justice
59 determines that approving the request would serve the
60 public interest, he or she shall appoint a visiting
61 judge. The visiting judge shall serve until the final
62 adjudication of the matter for which he or she was
63 appointed. A visiting judge appointment shall confer on
64 the visiting judge all powers, authority, and
65 jurisdiction of the respective judgeship to which he or
66 she has been appointed.

67 (e) The court shall hold a hearing on the petition
68 and shall grant the petition if the court is reasonably
69 satisfied from the evidence that the petitioner is
70 entitled to restitution pursuant to this section.

71 (f) (1) Following any award of restitution under this
72 section, the Class 3 municipality shall have not less



73 than six months to make complete the payment of the
74 restitution. Thereafter, if the restitution payments have
75 not been completed, the Class 3 municipality shall become
76 ineligible to receive any of the following:

77 a. Any state grant, gift, endowment, or any other sum
78 of money or aid from the State of Alabama or a
79 department, board, or agency thereof.

80 b. Any allocation of state revenues directly shared
81 with local governing bodies not otherwise guaranteed by
82 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, including, but not
83 limited to, revenue from the Rebuild Alabama Act, Act
84 2019-2, 2019 1st Special Session; and the net profits
85 derived from the proceeds of the Alabama liquor stores as
86 provided under Section 28-3-74, Code of Alabama 1975.

87 (2) The Finance Director shall direct the Comptroller
88 to withhold the distribution of revenue described under
89 this subsection to which the Class 3 municipality would
90 otherwise be entitled into a special fund within the
91 State Treasury. The Legislature, by independent
92 supplemental appropriation, may use monies in the special
93 fund to satisfy the restitution payments.
