4 SYNOPSIS:

5 Under existing law, termination dates are  
6 established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies  
7 are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset  
8 Committee. After the review process is completed, the  
9 committee prepares its recommendation for the agencies  
10 to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which  
11 either continue, terminate, or continue with  
12 modification each agency reviewed.

13 This bill would provide for the continuance of  
14 the Alabama Board of Electrical Contractors until  
15 October 1, 2028.

22 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
23 existence and functioning of the Alabama Board of Electrical  
24 Contractors until October 1, 2028.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
27 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama  
28 Board of Electrical Contractors until October 1, 2028.





## **SB101 INTRODUCED**

29           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama  
30 Board of Electrical Contractors, created and functioning  
31 pursuant to Sections 34-36-1 to 34-36-18, inclusive, Code of  
32 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2028, and those  
33 code sections are expressly preserved.

34           Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
35 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
36 Sections 1 and 2.

37           Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,  
38 2026.
