## 4     SYNOPSIS:

5                   Under existing law, termination dates are  
6                   established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies  
7                   are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset  
8                   Committee. After the review process is completed, the  
9                   committee prepares its recommendation for the agencies  
10                  to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which  
11                  either continue, terminate, or continue with  
12                  modification each agency reviewed.

13                  This bill would provide for the continuance of  
14                  the Alabama Private Investigation Board until October  
15                  1, 2028.

22                  Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
23                  existence and functioning of the Alabama Private Investigation  
24                  Board until October 1, 2028.

25                  BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26                  Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
27                  Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama  
28                  Private Investigation Board until October 1, 2028.

29           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama  
30       Private Investigation Board, created and functioning pursuant  
31       to Sections 34-25B-1 to 34-25B-54, inclusive, Code of Alabama  
32       1975, is continued until October 1, 2028, and those code  
33       sections are expressly preserved.

34           Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
35       recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
36       Sections 1 and 2.

37           Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,  
38       2026.
