1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975,
5 those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during
6 the 2025 Regular Session, as contained in the 2025 Cumulative
7 Supplements to certain volumes of the code; and to adopt and
8 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, the 2025 Cumulative
9 Supplements to local law volumes; to make corrections in
10 certain volumes of the cumulative supplements and replacement
11 volumes; to specify that this adoption and incorporation
12 constitutes a continuous systematic codification of the entire
13 Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a
14 code; to expressly provide that this act does not affect any
15 2026 session statutes; and to specify the duties of the
16 Secretary of State regarding the custody of the cumulative
17 supplements and replacement volumes.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of the
20 state enacted during the 2025 Regular Session as contained in
21 the 2025 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 22A,
22 inclusive, and the additions and deletions made by the Code
23 Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published
24 by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of
25 the 2025 Cumulative Supplements are identified and
26 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed
27 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the
28 cumulative supplements and upon the first inside page and the



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29 last inside page of the replacement volumes, are adopted and
30 incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

31 (b) The following corrections are made:

33 Volume 8, page 109. To revise an internal citation to reflect
34 the relettering of hierarchical units within Section 40-10-132
35 by Act 2024-83, in paragraph (9)b., replace "Section
36 40-10-132(a)(2)" with "Section 40-10-132(b)(2)"

37 (2) "Section 13A-12-3.5, Volume 12A, page 629. To
38 conform the age prohibition referenced in subdivision (1) to
39 amendments made by Act 2021-453, replace the language "19
40 Years of Age" with "21 Years of Age"

41 (3) Section 13A-12-3.8, 2025 Cumulative Supplement to
42 Volume 12A, page 173. To correct a typographical error and
43 reference to apparently intended code section, in subsection
44 (a), replace "Section 28-11-4" with "Section 28-11-7"

45 (4) Section 17-3-2, 2025 Cumulative Supplement to
46 Volume 13B, page 3. To correct a publishing error, in the
47 second sentence of subdivision (a)(1), replace the language
48 "the that county" with "the county"

49 (5) Section 39-2-2, 2025 Cumulative Supplement to
50 Volume 20, page 181. To correct a clerical error and reference
51 the apparently intended agency, in subdivision (b)(3), replace
52 the language "the Department of Finance may" with "the
53 Department of Transportation may"

54 (6) Section 45-16A-40.07, 2025 Cumulative Supplement to
55 Volume 22D, page 147. To correct a grammatical error, at the
56 end of the first sentence, replace ". If" with ", and if"



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57 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state
58 pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2025 Regular
59 Session, as contained in the 2025 Cumulative Supplements to
60 Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 22J, 22K, 22L,
61 22M, and 22N and the 2025 Regular Session additions and
62 deletions made by the Code Commissioner for editorial
63 purposes, as edited and published by Thomson Reuters, as the
64 Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2025 Cumulative
65 Supplements are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal
66 of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each
67 of the volumes of the cumulative supplements, are adopted and
68 incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

69 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
70 supplements specified in this act shall constitute a
71 continuous systematic codification of the entire Code of
72 Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the Constitution
73 of Alabama of 2022. This act is a law that adopts a code for
74 the purposes of Section 45 of the Constitution of Alabama of
75 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this act shall
76 be deemed to codify any provision of law that was adopted in
77 violation of any provision of the Constitution of Alabama of
78 2022, establishing requirements for, or limitations on, the
79 enactment of a law.

80 Section 4. The adoption of this act shall not repeal,
81 supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute
82 enacted into law during any 2026 session of the Legislature.

83 Section 5. Upon passage and approval of this act, the
84 duly authenticated volumes of the 2025 Cumulative Supplements



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85 shall be transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file
86 the volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in
87 that office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement
88 volumes shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary
89 of State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under
90 proper certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any
91 part or parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law
92 for similar services.

93 Section 6. This act shall become effective immediately.
