1 Enrolled, An Act,

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3 To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year  
4 ending September 30, 2026: from the Personnel Fund to the  
5 State Personnel Department in the amount of \$1,268,538; from  
6 federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act - State Small  
7 Business Credit Initiative Fund to the Department of Finance  
8 in the amount of \$34,000,000, estimated; from the Federal  
9 Stimulus Fund to Alabama Medicaid Agency in the amount of  
10 \$588,612; from the Alabama Energy Infrastructure Fund to State  
11 Industrial Development Authority in the amount of \$16,000,000;  
12 from the Strategic Energy Infrastructure Development Fund to  
13 State Industrial Development Authority in the amount of  
14 \$50,000,000; from the Administrative Office of Courts Federal  
15 and Local Funds Fund to the Unified Judicial System in the  
16 amount of \$3,600,000; from the Court Automation Fund to the  
17 Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$2,300,000; from the  
18 Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to the Unified  
19 Judicial System in the amount of \$1,000,000; from the State  
20 Judicial Administration Fund to the Unified Judicial System in  
21 the amount of \$4,100,000; from the Genetic Counseling Fund to  
22 the Alabama Board of Genetic Counseling in the amount of  
23 \$32,000; to transfer \$2,000,000 from the Bureau of Tourism and  
24 Travel Fund to the Alabama Site Development Fund; from the  
25 Alabama Site Development Fund to the State Industrial  
26 Development Authority in the amount of \$2,000,000; to transfer  
27 \$1,000,000 from the Bureau of Tourism and Travel Fund to the  
28 Game and Fish Fund; from the Game and Fish Fund to the



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29 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources in the amount  
30 of \$1,000,000; to transfer up to \$22,137,949 from the  
31 Refundable Tax Credit Fund to the Legislative Council Fund; to  
32 transfer up to \$13,000,000 from the Real Property Management  
33 Fund to the Legislative Council Fund; from the Legislative  
34 Council Fund to the Legislative Council in the amount of  
35 \$35,137,949; from the Vaping and Licensing Enforcement Fund to  
36 the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in the amount of  
37 \$1,000,000; from the Consumable Hemp Product Compliance Fund  
38 to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in the amount  
39 of \$1,000,000; from the Geological Survey Library Revolving  
40 Fund to Geological Survey in the amount of \$50,000; from the  
41 Youth Services Reimbursement Fund for Diversion Programs to  
42 the Department of Youth Services in the amount of \$750,000;  
43 from the Public Road and Bridge Fund to the Alabama Department  
44 of Transportation in the amount of \$387,500,000; from the  
45 Rebuild Alabama Fund to the Alabama Department of  
46 Transportation in the amount of \$200,000,000; from the  
47 Broadband Accessibility Fund to the Alabama Department of  
48 Economic and Community Affairs in the amount of \$30,000,000;  
49 and to amend Act 2025-251, the General Fund Appropriation Bill  
50 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, to increase the  
51 amount appropriated to the Alabama Department of  
52 Transportation for paying the principal of and interest on  
53 bonds issued for the purposes of public highways and bridges  
54 and add the Alabama Highway Authority to the list of entities  
55 for which the aggregate debt service amount is appropriated.  
56 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:



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57           Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations  
58 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
59 \$1,268,538 from the Personnel Fund to the State Personnel  
60 Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

61           Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations  
62 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
63 \$34,000,000, estimated, in federal funds from the American  
64 Rescue Plan Act - State Small Business Credit Initiative Fund  
65 to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending  
66 September 30, 2026. These funds may be delegated through  
67 memoranda of agreement to the Alabama Innovation Corporation  
68 or other entity so designated by the Department of Finance.

69           Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations  
70 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
71 \$588,612 from the Federal Stimulus Fund to Alabama Medicaid  
72 Agency for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

73           Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations  
74 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
75 \$16,000,000 from the Alabama Energy Infrastructure Fund to the  
76 State Industrial Development Authority for the fiscal year  
77 ending September 30, 2026.

78           Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations  
79 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
80 \$50,000,000 from the Strategic Energy Infrastructure  
81 Development Fund to the State Industrial Development Authority  
82 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

83           Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations  
84 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated



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85 \$3,600,000 from the Administrative Office of Courts Federal  
86 and Local Funds Fund to the Unified Judicial System for the  
87 fiscal year ending September 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law  
88 to the contrary, the funds appropriated under this section may  
89 be spent on salaries and personnel costs and for other general  
90 operations of the Unified Judicial System.

91 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations  
92 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
93 \$2,300,000 from the Court Automation Fund to the Unified  
94 Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.  
95 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds  
96 appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and  
97 personnel costs and for other general operations of the  
98 Unified Judicial System.

99 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations  
100 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
101 \$1,000,000 from the Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund  
102 to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending  
103 September 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,  
104 the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on  
105 salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations  
106 of the Unified Judicial System.

107 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations  
108 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
109 \$4,100,000 from the State Judicial Administration Fund to the  
110 Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September  
111 30, 2026. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds  
112 appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and



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113 personnel costs and for other general operations of the  
114 Unified Judicial System.

115 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations  
116 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
117 \$32,000 from the Genetic Counseling Fund to the Alabama Board  
118 of Genetic Counseling for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
119 2026.

120 Section 11. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
121 2026, \$2,000,000 shall be transferred from the Bureau of  
122 Tourism and Travel Fund to the Alabama Site Development Fund.

123 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations  
124 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
125 \$2,000,000 from the Alabama Site Development Fund to the State  
126 Industrial Development Authority for the Site Evaluation  
127 Economic Development Strategy pursuant to Article 2D, Chapter  
128 10 of Title 41, Code of Alabama 1975, for fiscal year ending  
129 September 30, 2026.

130 Section 13. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
131 2026, up to \$22,137,949 shall be transferred from the  
132 Refundable Tax Credit Fund to the Legislative Council Fund.

133 Section 14. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
134 2026, \$13,000,000 shall be transferred from the Real Property  
135 Management Fund to the Legislative Council Fund.

136 Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations  
137 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated up  
138 to \$35,137,949 from the Legislative Council Fund to the  
139 Legislative Council for construction and related expenses for  
140 the new State House for fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.



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141 Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations  
142 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
143 \$1,000,000 from the Vaping and Licensing Enforcement Fund to  
144 the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for fiscal year  
145 ending September 30, 2026.

146 Section 17. In addition to all other appropriations  
147 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated up  
148 to \$1,000,000 from the Consumable Hemp Product Compliance Fund  
149 to the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for fiscal  
150 year ending September 30, 2026.

151 Section 18. In addition to all other appropriations  
152 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
153 \$50,000 from the Geological Survey Library Revolving Fund to  
154 Geological Survey for fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

155 Section 19. In addition to all other appropriations  
156 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
157 \$750,000 from the Youth Services Reimbursement Fund for  
158 Diversion Programs to the Department of Youth Services for  
159 fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

160 Section 20. In addition to all other appropriations  
161 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
162 \$387,500,000 from the Public Road and Bridge Fund to the  
163 Alabama Department of Transportation for fiscal year ending  
164 September 30, 2026.

165 Section 21. In addition to all other appropriations  
166 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
167 \$200,000,000 from the Rebuild Alabama Fund to the Alabama  
168 Department of Transportation for fiscal year ending September



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169 30, 2026.

170 Section 22. In addition to all other appropriations  
171 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
172 \$30,000,000 from the Broadband Accessibility Fund to the  
173 Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for  
174 fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

175 Section 23. For the fiscal year ending September 30,  
176 2026, \$1,000,000 shall be transferred from the Bureau of  
177 Tourism and Travel Fund to the Game and Fish Fund.

178 Section 24. In addition to all other appropriations  
179 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
180 \$1,000,000 from the Game and Fish Fund to the Alabama  
181 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the  
182 Alabama State Wildlife Action Plan for fiscal year ending  
183 September 30, 2026.

184 Section 25. Section 3C of Act 2025-251, the General  
185 Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
186 2026, is hereby amended as follows:

187 "124. Transportation Department of...

188 There is hereby appropriated for payment of the  
189 principal of and the interest on all bonds heretofore or  
190 hereafter issued for public highways and bridge purposes, or  
191 either, by the State of Alabama, Alabama Federal Aid Highway  
192 Finance Authority, Alabama Highway Finance Corporation, ~~or~~  
193 Alabama Industrial Access Road and Bridge Corporation, or  
194 Alabama Highway Authority, a total of ~~\$133,755,861~~  
195 \$193,564,457 or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
196 payment of said principal and interest at their respective



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197 maturities, of the revenues pledged for such payment. There is  
198 also hereby appropriated an amount not to exceed \$25,000,000  
199 as an annual contribution to the Alabama Transportation  
200 Infrastructure Bank, if needed, for payment of debt service.  
201 The Director of Transportation, with the consent of the  
202 Governor and the Director of Finance, shall have the authority  
203 to transfer any appropriation or any portion thereof between  
204 and among subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) of this section  
205 whenever such transfer shall be necessary to assure maximum  
206 utilization of federal matching funds which shall become  
207 available. In the event that there shall not be sufficient  
208 funds available for payment of all appropriations hereinabove  
209 made, the following provisions shall be applicable. In the  
210 event of such insufficiency in respect of said revenues  
211 accruing to the Department of Transportation: (1) the  
212 appropriation made for Debt Service in subdivisions (a) and  
213 (b) hereof shall be paid in full, and (2) the appropriations  
214 from the revenues accruing to the Department of Transportation  
215 that are herein made for the purposes referred to in  
216 subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) except for Debt Service, hereof  
217 shall be allocated among the purposes referred to in said  
218 subdivisions in such order and with such priorities as the  
219 Director of the Department of Transportation shall from time  
220 to time direct. The funds appropriated in subdivisions (a) and  
221 (c) hereof, for the matching federal funds, shall not revert  
222 at the end of the fiscal year for which such appropriations  
223 are made but shall remain available for the purposes for which  
224 such appropriations were made. In addition to all



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225 appropriations hereinabove made, there is hereby appropriated  
226 to the Department of Transportation all federal funds accruing  
227 thereto to be expended only for the purpose for which such  
228 funds are made available."

229           Section 26. Notwithstanding any other provisions of  
230 this act or any other act, any amounts from appropriations for  
231 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, to the various  
232 state agencies in this act which were unexpended and reverted  
233 on September 30, 2026, are hereby reappropriated to the  
234 respective offices for the fiscal year beginning October 1,  
235 2026.

236           Section 27. This act shall become effective immediately  
237 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its  
238 otherwise becoming law.
