SYNOPSIS:

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Henry County, to levy a temporary ad valorem tax of three mills south of Sandy Creek for public school purposes for projects in Headland.

A BILL

AN ACT

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Henry County, to levy an ad valorem tax of three mills south of Sandy Creek for public school purposes in Headland.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

(a) In addition to all other ad valorem taxes, beginning with the tax year for which taxes become due and payable on October 1, 2027, and continuing through September 30, 2034, there is levied an ad valorem tax on all taxable property located in Henry County and south of Sandy Creek at a

29 rate of three mills per dollar of assessed value.

30 (b) The proceeds of the tax shall be used exclusively
31 for public school purposes for projects in Headland.

32 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
33 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
34 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
35 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
36 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
37 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
38 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
39 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize
40 language; and translate effective dates.

41 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

42 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
43 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
44 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
45 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
46 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
47 the election ballot and shall set forth the following
48 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
49 constitutional amendment:

50 "Relating to Henry County, proposing an amendment to
51 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to levy a temporary ad
52 valorem tax of three mills on taxable property located south
53 of Sandy Creek to support public school projects in Headland.

54 Proposed by Act ____."

55 This description shall be followed by the following
56 language:

57 "Yes() No()."

58 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
59 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by
60 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
