10 Basketball Team has once again demonstrated unparalleled  
11 excellence, skill, and sportsmanship by capturing the 2026  
12 National Intercollegiate Wheelchair Basketball Tournament  
13 National Championship on April 4, 2026, in Tucson, Arizona;

15 WHEREAS, by defeating The University of Texas at  
16 Arlington with a score of 55-37 in the title game, the  
17 Crimson Tide secured its sixth consecutive national title,  
18 extending a historic era of dominance in collegiate  
19 athletics; and

20 WHEREAS, this victory marks the program's 12th  
21 overall national championship since 2009, a testament to the  
22 enduring culture of success and grit established at The  
23 University of Alabama; and

24 WHEREAS, under the expert leadership of Head Coach  
25 Ryan Hynes, the team finished the 2025-2026 season with an  
26 impressive 22-3 record, including a 15-2 record against the  
27 conference; and

30 Alabama with 24 points on 9 of 17 from the field, 11  
31 rebounds, and seven assists, playing all 40 minutes; Bailey  
32 Moody also finished with a double-double, as she logged 11  
33 points and a team-high 16 rebounds in 35 minutes of action,  
34 while Joy Haizelden was given the tournament MVP award; and
