7 WHEREAS, highest commendations and congratulations  
8 are herein proudly presented to Gardendale First Baptist  
9 Church on the momentous occasion of its 150th Anniversary;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, Gardendale First Baptist Church has survived  
12 throughout the years by the commitment of its pastors and  
13 members and by the loving grace of God; many generations of  
14 members have been encouraged and their faith strengthened  
15 through the leadership of this church; it has grown into a  
16 beacon of unselfish love and compassion for the community;  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, in 1876, under the leadership of the  
19 church's first pastor of record, Elder James Grimes, a group  
20 of believers established a permanent place of worship known  
21 as Chalybeate Springs Baptist Church, with an initial  
22 membership of 27; and

23 WHEREAS, the congregation moved to Main Street, now  
24 the Lighthouse Building, in 1914, and three years later the  
25 church changed its name to Gardendale First Baptist Church;  
26 and

27 WHEREAS, over the ensuing years, successive pastors  
28 provided leadership that strengthened and improved the

29 church family; and

30 WHEREAS, in 1934, Reverend C. B. Phillips became the  
31 church's first full-time pastor, followed by Howard Bryant  
32 in 1961, Lewis Marler in 1970, David Dykes in 1984, and  
33 Steve Gaines in 1991; and

34 WHEREAS, the church has experienced steady growth and  
35 stability, along with improvements and purchases that have  
36 supported its ministries; and

37 WHEREAS, following the guidance of the Holy Spirit,  
38 Dr. Kevin Hamm was installed as pastor in 2006, and under  
39 his leadership the church has grown to a membership of more  
40 than 6,000, drawing members from Jefferson County and the  
41 surrounding areas; and

42 WHEREAS, in 2010, the church moved to its present  
43 location alongside Interstate 65 in Gardendale and has  
44 become known as the "church with the cross," referring to  
45 the 125-foot cross visible from the interstate, which  
46 represents God's love to the hundreds of thousands of people  
47 who pass by each year; and

48 WHEREAS, the church remains committed to four core  
49 values that guide the church's ministry to focus on  
50 fostering a relationship with Christ, community, and  
51 outreach: Worship God, Make Disciples, Love People, and  
52 Share Jesus; and

53 WHEREAS, with the help of its dedicated congregation  
54 and the leadership of its pastors through the years,  
55 Gardendale First Baptist Church has faithfully shared the  
56 Word and love of God, strengthened lives, and brought people

57 together in fellowship and worship for 150 years; now
