SJR\_\_\_\_\_ CONGRATULATING THE STANHOPE ELMORE BOYS BOWLING TEAM FOR WINNING THE CLASS 6A/7A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, highest commendations are herein conveyed to the Stanhope Elmore Boys Bowling Team on the occasion of capturing the 2026 Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA) Division 6A/7A Boys Bowling Championship; and

WHEREAS, the championship was held on January 30, 2026, at Bowlero Bowling Center in Mobile, Alabama, where the Mustangs toppled an impressive 1,559 pins to earn the Division 6A/7A Blue Map; and

WHEREAS, this victory marks an historic achievement, as the Mustangs became the first boys bowling team to win the AHSAA State Championship in the history of the boys' program, cementing their place in local sports history; and

WHEREAS, Stanhope Elmore High School has been a strong contender in high school bowling since the program was reinstated during the 2015-2016 school year, and after years of exceptional talent and perseverance, securing the State Championship title represents a victory for every previous team member over the past decade; and

WHEREAS, the Mustangs secured the title by defeating the Hoover Buccaneers in a dramatic comeback during the final game of a double-elimination tournament; after

29 trailing by a 50-pin deficit late in the competition, the  
30 Mustangs rallied to win by a 28-pin margin; and

31 WHEREAS, remarkably, the team achieved this  
32 championship with a small roster of only six bowlers,  
33 leaving virtually no opportunity for substitutions  
34 throughout the tournament; and

35 WHEREAS, on a team filled with champion bowlers,  
36 several athletes were recognized for their exceptional  
37 performances: Seth Wilson was named by the AHSAA as the No.  
38 1 bowler at the tournament, and Drake Abbott was named the  
39 No. 7 bowler; additionally, Seth Wilson and Ryan Best were  
40 selected by the Alabama High School Bowling Coaches  
41 Association to the First Team All-State and the 6A/7A State  
42 Team; and

43 WHEREAS, under the expert leadership of AHSAA Coach  
44 of the Year Head Coach Kenny Wilson, who inspired his  
45 players by reminding them throughout the tournament that  
46 "skill beats luck every time," and Assistant Coach Bridget  
47 Wilson, the Stanhope Elmore team demonstrated unwavering  
48 commitment after years of contention, ultimately claiming  
49 the championship they worked tirelessly to achieve; and

50 WHEREAS, the team's remarkable season was made  
51 possible due to the talent and dedication of its  
52 student-athletes: Ryan Best, Dequan Brown, David Henriquez,  
53 Seth Wilson, Drake Abbott, and Alex Gilbert; and
