4 SJR____ EXTENDING THE ALABAMA RURAL ROAD MAP INITIATIVE.

6 WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution 92, enacted as Act
7 2025-425 in the 2025 Regular Session, strongly encouraged
8 the Alabama Growth Alliance to develop an Alabama Rural
9 Roadmap initiative to serve as the cornerstone of a
10 comprehensive statewide rural development program designed
11 to provide recommendations to revitalize and empower
12 Alabama's rural communities under the direction of a strong
13 leadership team; and

14 WHEREAS, Act 2025-425 provided that the Alabama Rural
15 Roadmap would be completed no later than the fifth
16 legislative day of the 2026 Regular Session, at which point
17 the initiative would be dissolved; and

18 WHEREAS, the Alabama Growth Alliance and the
19 leadership team of the initiative need additional time to
20 develop and implement a robust statewide rural development
21 program to secure a brighter and more prosperous future for
22 all Alabamians, regardless of geographic location; now
23 therefore,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
25 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Alabama Rural Road Map
26 initiative, created pursuant to Act 2025-425, 2025 Regular
27 Session, is extended.

28 (a) The Legislature strongly encourages the Alabama
29 Growth Alliance to continue to work with the leadership team
30 to develop the Alabama Rural Roadmap initiative.

31 (b) The Alabama Rural Roadmap shall be completed and
32 submitted to the Governor, the Chair of the Senate Fiscal
33 Responsibility and Economic Development Committee, the Chair
34 of the House of Representatives Fiscal Responsibility
35 Committee, and the Secretary of the Alabama Department of
36 Commerce no later than November 1, 2026, at which point the
37 initiative shall stand dissolved of any future duties.
