13 WHEREAS, advancing nuclear energy technology will
14 drive innovation, fuel economic growth, and create
15 high-paying jobs; and

17 deliver affordable, reliable, and secure energy needed to
18 power the nation's future; and

19 WHEREAS, Alabama is an emerging national leader in
20 advanced technologies, including, but not limited to,
21 aerospace and defense, advanced manufacturing, large-scale
